The Dream Land DG 737 LED LCD has 150 Ansi-Lumen, a contrast of 600:1 and a VGA 640 x 480 resolution. As Digital Galaxy specifies the brightness of the projector in lumens, we have calculated an approximate Ansi lumen value in this case. The projector can illuminate a screen width of up to 107 cm well thanks to the 150 Ansi lumens. In room lighting, however, the picture width should ideally be less than 71 cm. On the market since 2012, the model is no longer offered by the manufacturer Digital Galaxy.

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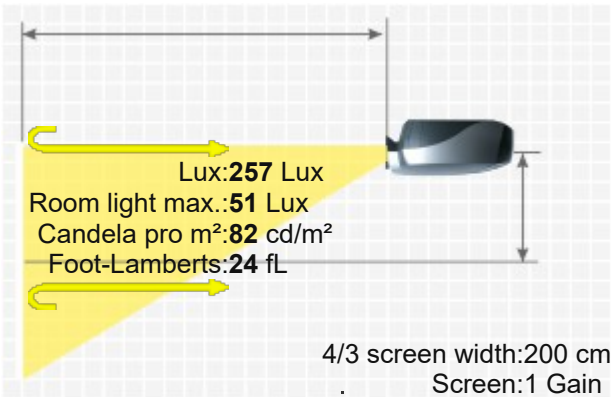
